

Cast and suggested wardrobe

Storytellers (ST1 and ST2)	Two individuals or two small groups. TV reporter-type clothes.
Red Riding Hood (RRH)	Red cape with hood.
Mother (M)	Mother-type clothes and an apron.
Granny (G)	Night attire and a pair of glasses.
Wolf (W)	Two felt ears and dark clothing. Optional trimmings can be tail, teeth etc.
Hunter (H)	Outdoor clothing.

Note

The parts of **Mother**, **Granny** and the **Hunter** can be read by the same person, changing the voice to suit each character.



ST1	Hello! I am Story Teller One ...
ST2	... and I am Story Teller Two.
ST1	This is the famous fairytale called Little Red Riding Hood.
ST2	While we are telling this story, our five senses or the way we use them will be mentioned quite often.
ST1 & 2	As you probably already know, our five senses are ... (<i>ad lib extra touches here</i>)



SIGHT



TOUCH



HEARING



TASTE



and SMELL

ST1	Our senses give us important information about our surroundings. They also help us learn things and stay safe.
ST2	Without our senses, we couldn't SEE, FEEL, HEAR, TASTE or SMELL.
ST1	How awful!
ST2	And we wouldn't FEEL hot or cold.
ST1	We couldn't SEE where we were going...
ST2	... or TASTE our dinner ...
ST1	... or SMELL a perfumed rose ...
ST2	... or HEAR a bird sing.
ST1	Our senses are certainly VERY important!

ST2	Let's now introduce the characters in this famous story.
M	I'm Mother. I've just made a cake for Granny using the TASTIEST fruit from the apple trees in the garden.
G	<i>(cough)</i> I'm Granny. I don't FEEL at all well. I'll be in my cottage at the other side of the forest READING my book.
W	I am the Wolf. I'm going to stay out of SIGHT behind some bushes in the forest to WATCH what is going on.
H	I am a Hunter with very keen EYESIGHT and excellent HEARING . I'm off to check for rabbits in the fields quite a long way away, so I must leave immediately.

ST1	And now let's begin our story.
RRH	That apple cake SMELLS delicious, Mother dear! I can SEE steam rising so I know not to TOUCH it as it is still very hot.
M	After it has cooled, I'll pack a basket of goodies for Granny. I'll meet you at Granny's house a bit later as I need to make another cake for your school fete.
RRH	I love visiting Granny. She'll be so happy to SEE me.
M	We have been to Granny's cottage many times before, so you know the way. All you have to do is follow the path.



M	Now remember to go straight to Granny's cottage, Little Red Riding Hood. Don't talk to strangers.
RRH	I'll remember. I'll go straight there.
ST2	And so off she went.
